4. Title Transportation of waste on state waters

5. Summary/Purpose: The bill would eliminate the stacking limitation for certain on barges and would repeal the prohibition on transporting waste on the Rappahannock, James, and York Rivers. The bill also would expand the uses of the waste-barging feet to cover not only administrative and enforcement costs but also of fund activities to abate pollution caused by barging of waste, to improve water quality, or for other environmental improvement purposes.

6. Fiscal impact: There will be no additional costs associated with implementation of this legislation. Any revenue associated with this legislation would be determined and implemented through the regulatory process and therefore the fiscal impact associated with this bill cannot be determined at this time.
