4. Title Voluntary contributions by hunters

5. Summary/Purpose: The bill directs the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries to allow persons, when they purchase hunting licenses and permits, to voluntarily contribute two dollars to Hunters For The Hungry. The contributions will be deposited into a special nonreverting fund of the Game Protection Fund and the monies disbursed quarterly to the Hunters for the Hungry.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are not available.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: The bill would impose a minor administrative impact on the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries. The department would have to redesign the hunting license to provide a place for hunters to designate a two-dollar contribution to the Hunters for the Hungry. However, such costs are estimated to be minor and are indeterminate at this time.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Department of Game and Inland Fisheries.

10. Technical amendment necessary: Yes, line 26, strike "know" and insert "known".

11. Other comments: HB1874 is an identical bill introduced by Delegate Thomas.
