7 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

8 **1. § 1.** *In addition to the duties set forth in § 33.1-12 of the Code of Virginia, the Commonwealth*  
9 *Transportation Board shall establish reasonable fees to be collected by the Commonwealth*  
10 *Transportation Commissioner from any qualified entity for the purpose of participating in the Integrated*  
11 *Directional Sign Program (IDSP) administered by the Department of Transportation or its agents that is*  
12 *designed to provide information to the motoring public relating to gasoline and motor vehicle services,*  
13 *food, lodging, attractions or other categories as defined by the IDSP. Such fees shall be deposited into*  
14 *a special fund specifically accounted for and used by the Commissioner solely to defray the actual costs*  
15 *of supervising and administering the signage programs. Included in these costs shall be a reasonable*  
16 *margin, not to exceed ten percent, in the nature of a reserve Fund.*

17 **2. That the Commonwealth Transportation Board shall report no later than August 1, 2005, on**  
18 **the actions it has taken relative to adjusting fees as a result of this Act.**

19 **3. That the Department of Transportation is hereby directed to review (i) the feasibility and**  
20 **desirability of auctioning certain travel services (logo) signs for which there are more businesses**  
21 **interested in locating on the sign than there is space to accommodate and (ii) concerning Gas**  
22 **Category I, a change from 16 hours per day to 24 hours per day. The results of such review shall**  
23 **be reported to the Senate and House Transportation Committees no later than August 1, 2005.**
