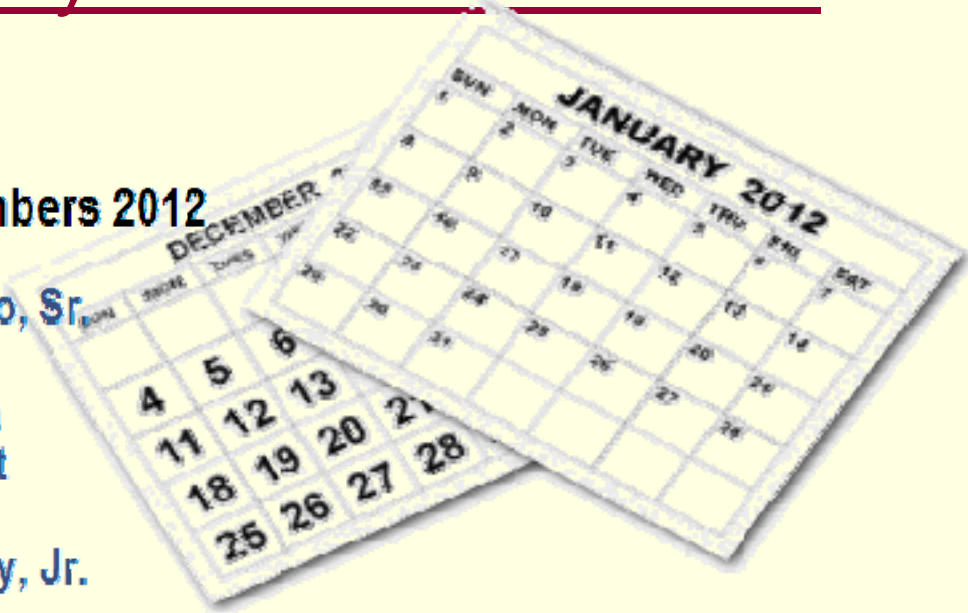

**December 30<sup>th</sup>** - All drafts of legislation to be prefiled will be returned to requesters for review by midnight.

Members have until 10 a.m. on the first day of session, Wednesday, January 11<sup>th</sup>, to submit those prefiled bills. After that, any bills submitted count towards their bill limit. House members have a 5 bill limit. Senate members have an 8 bill limit.

# The 2012 General Assembly Session



**December 19<sup>th</sup> - Budget.** Introduction by the Governor.

**January 11th - Session begins.** It always begins on the second Wednesday in January.

**Friday, January 20th – Bill cut off.** Final date to submit any legislation for introduction.

**February 14th - Bill crossover.** Both bodies have to complete their own legislation by midnight.

**March 10th - Last day of session.** Sine die. Most always occurs on Saturday unless the session is extended by a change to the operating resolution.



**April 18th - Reconvene Session.** Governor's recommendations and veto's are taken up.

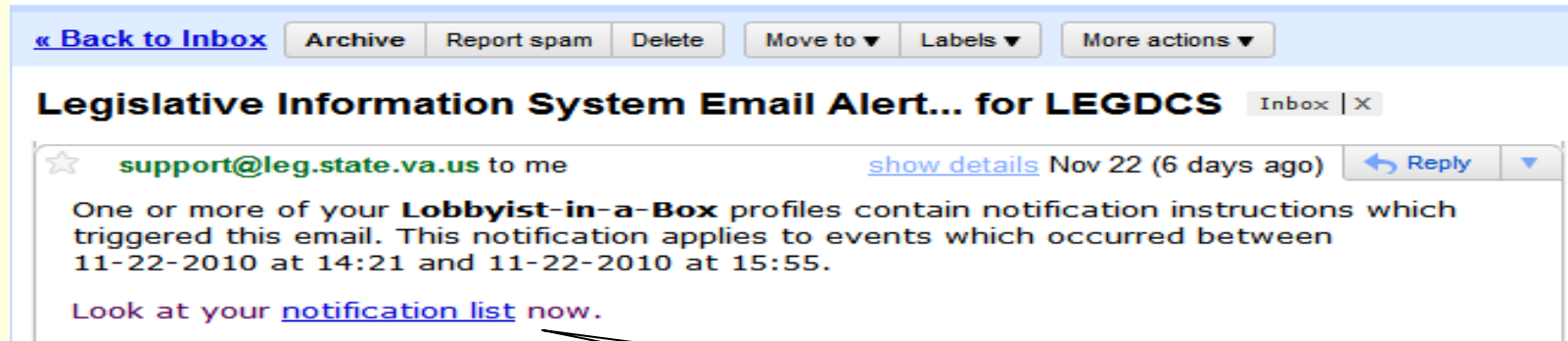



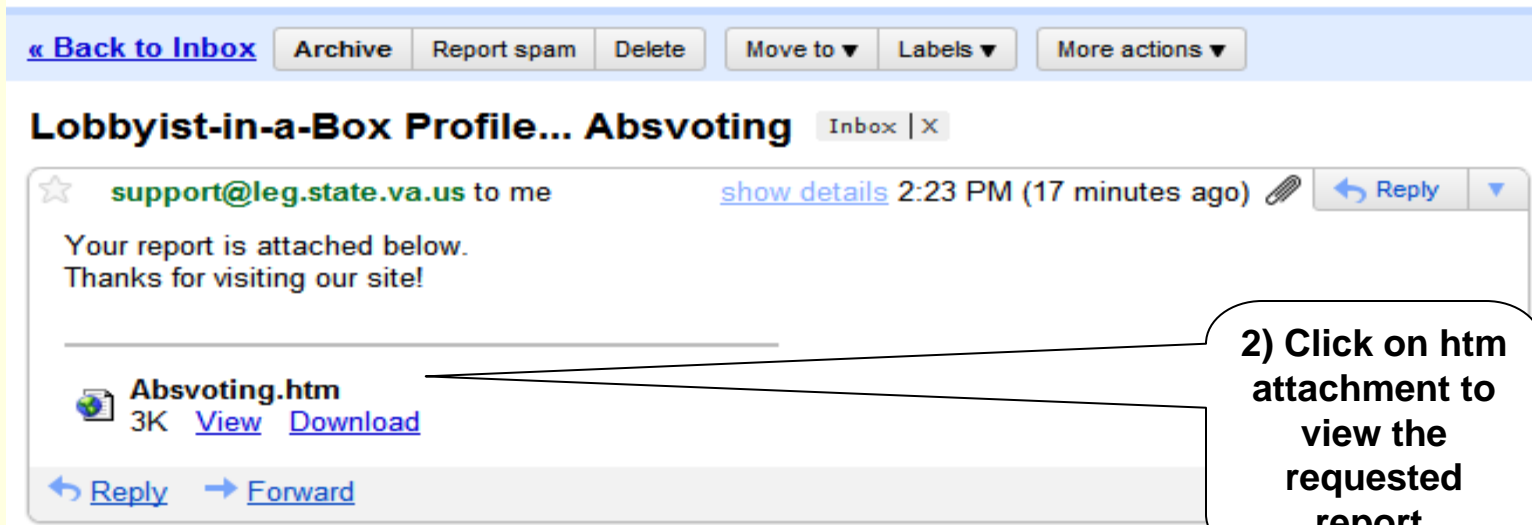
